LAKEMONT PARK HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER BASKETBALL LEAGUE RULES – 2026

1. **Entry Fee** is \$450 per team. Entry fee is due no later than **Friday, May 22, 2026, at 3:45 p.m.** Check is payable to the Central Blair Recreation Commission. Mail or hand-deliver to the Recreation Office, 2101 5th Avenue, Altoona, PA 16602. Schedules will be e-mailed to your team's coach. Your team's coach has the responsibility to inform team players. If you need hard copies, you can request them by calling 814-949-2231.

Rosters must be turned in and signed by **Friday, May 22, 2026, at the Recreation Office. No additions to rosters after Tuesday, May 26, 2026.**

- **Mandatory** league meeting is Thursday, May 28, 2026, at **6:00 PM at Lakemont Park**. A representative from each team **is required** to attend this meeting. .

2. The League structure and amount of playoff teams will be determined after registration closes.
 1. Ties for playoff positions are decided by head to head competition and point differential.
3. If it is raining and you are not sure if the games are going to be played, check the Commission's Facebook page.
4. In the event of cancellations. A make-up schedule will be e-mailed to your team's coach. **TEAM COACHES** are responsible for informing team members of changes in schedules.
5. Games will be played at Lakemont Park.
6. Each roster is limited to 15 players.
7. Games will consist of two, twenty-minute halves. The clock runs the first 18 minutes of each half and will be stopped for violations the last two minutes of each half. If the game is tied after regulation play, three-minute overtime will be played. The clock will run for the first minute and will be stopped for violations the last two minutes.
8. Time-outs: two per half will be given, and remaining time-outs cannot be carried over to second half. One time out is awarded for each overtime period.
9. With five personal fouls, a player is out of the game.

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10. Seven team fouls result in one-plus-one. With 10 team fouls, 2 shots are awarded.
11. If you are fouled on a three-point shot attempt, player will receive three free throws.
12. **Technical** - A player receiving one technical in one game will be out for the current game and receive a one game suspension on the next game played. If player does not sit for the next game played, the game will be forfeited. With two technicals accumulated result in a two-game suspension. On the following two games, if a player does not sit for the next two games, the games will be forfeited. With three technical's accumulated result in expulsion from the League. All technical fouls count towards total fouls.
13. **Any player/coach threatening an official, physical or verbal, will be suspended** until the matter is brought before the League Director and the Central Blair Recreation Commission staff. Final Decisions will be made by Central Blair Recreation Commission.
14. Fighting between players will result in expulsion from contest and will receive a two game suspension.
15. Change of possession after initial jump ball.
16. **All teams must have numbered uniforms or game will be forfeited.** Coaches are responsible for number changes taking place. Make sure scorekeeper is made aware before the start of the game.
17. Eligibility will be players entering ninth, tenth, eleventh and twelfth grades, for the 2026/2027 school year.
18. If a coach violates Rule #18 concerning eligibility, the team will forfeit the remaining games, as well as, being suspended for next year.
19. Player eligibility on rainouts: If a player is absent from a game that has been rained out, that player will be permitted to play when the game is made up.
20. No jewelry will be permitted during play.
21. Dunking is permitted in this League, however there will be no dunking during pre-game warmups.
22. All other P.I.A.A. rules apply.
